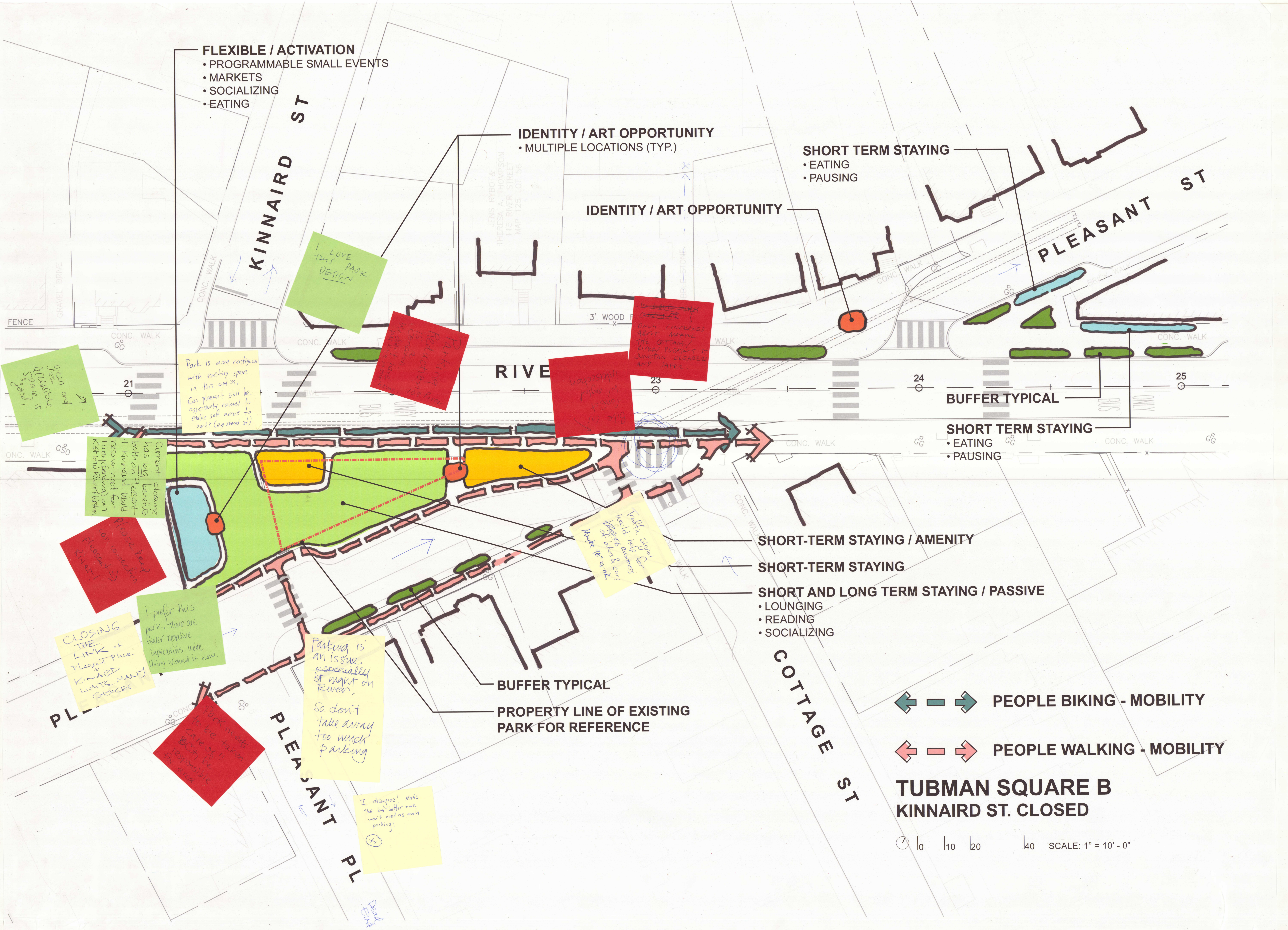
PROPERTY LINE OF EXISTING PARK FOR REFERENCE
