Homebound Delivery Application

Eligibility

The Cambridge Public Library offers monthly delivery of library materials to Cambridge residents who are homebound and unable to visit a library due to short- or long-term disability or infirmity.

How It Works

This service must be scheduled in advance and is reserved for eligible patrons. All circulating library materials are eligible for homebound delivery, including books, audiobook, DVDs and music CDs. Items are checked out for 4 weeks and can be renewed 2 times. We will deliver your materials during the second full week of the month on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. We will pick up your returns from the previous delivery at the same time. Library bags will be supplied for deliveries.
