• This corridor connects Watertown Square, Coolidge Square, and Harvard Square, including schools, residences, Mount Auburn Hospital, and major employers like athenahealth



- Two travel lanes in each direction and carries approximately 19,000 vehicles per day.
- The 71 and 73 carry 12,000 weekday daily riders combined, representing as much as one-third of the total number of people traveling though the corridor. In some locations, bus ridership is over half of users.



• One of the worst locations for delay and unreliability in the city, particularly in the morning in the inbound direction, as represented in the red shading below.



- Proposed Elements:
 - 1. All-day, dedicated bus lanes
 - 2. Inbound queue jump lanes
 - 3. Transit Signal Priority (TSP)
