PB#328, 10 North Point Boulevard, Special Permit application by EFEKTA Group, Inc. to construct a building with a Gross Floor Area of 300,000 square feet of institutional (dormitory and accessory uses), general office, education (other school), and retail (gym/fitness center and related retail) use as well as accessory above-grade structured parking on land currently owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts pursuant to Section 19.20 Project Review, Article 12.000 Planned Unit Development, and Section 13.70 North Point Residence district. The applicant requests the Planning Board to permit that (1) one hundred percent of the total authorized Gross Floor Area within the Development Parcel for the project, exclusive of GFA devoted to parking facilities, may consist of non-residential uses pursuant to Section13.73.0 and (2) retail use of approximately 12,000 square feet may be located on the ground floor pursuant to Section 13.73.1(i).

This will be the first of two required public hearings for the Planned Unit Development process as outlined in Article 12.000.
