



190 Brattle Street Cambridge, Massachusetts

The proposed exterior work to 190 Brattle Street is limited to the rear (south facing) elevation.

- Remove existing glass and metal greenhouse and concrete block knee wall. Construct a
 conservatory/yoga studio on the existing greenhouse foundation (plan dimensions to be identical to the
 greenhouse). Proposed studio structure to be painted wood frame with large operable and fixed
 insulating glass panels. Roof to be slightly pitched dark gray pvc membrane. See drawings for height
 comparison.
- 2. Remove three single light glass door panels from current dining room south elevation. Replace with three painted wood single light double hung windows.
- 3. Remove four single light glass door panels with transoms above from current kitchen. Replace with three painted wood single light glass door panels.
