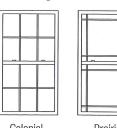

ENERGY STAR: This package includes everything that is needed for a product to meet ENERGY STAR requirements. Glazing, gas, glass thickness, etc. will vary by window and usually includes Low-E coating and Argon gas. This glazing package does qualify for ENERGY STAR.

U-factor measures the rate of non-solar heat transfer from one side of the window to the other. Heat transfer implies both heat loss out of a living space during cold weather and non-solar heat gain during hot summer months. The lower the U-factor, the better the performance.

Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) measures how well a product blocks heat from the sun. The lower the SHGC, the better a product is at blocking unwanted heat gain.

Visible Transmittance (VT) measures how much light comes through a product. The higher the VT, the more light that comes through.

SMART COATS PROPOSAL

Work Scope: 9 Story St, Cambridge MA 02138

Set Up & Clean Up:

- Maintain EPA Lead-Safe and OSHA Safety Standards at all times to ensure the welfare of residents and neighbors.
- All non-contracted surfaces will be protected by drop cloths, masking tape or otherwise shielded against unintentional damage or alteration of any kind.
- All materials and equipment will be stored in an acceptable area designated by owner.
- Clean up and vacuum will occur daily. Thoroughly clean around the entire contracted area of property upon completion.

General

- Remove and replace the exterior of the siding and trim
- Corbels and similar details will remain if they can be restored (otherwise, they will be replicated to match existing features)
- There are areas along the soffit and fascia details that have rot that will need to be repaired
- Replace all 34 windows (must be approved by the historical committee)

- Replace rear entry doors 30"X80"
- Remove all trash and materials at the end of the job

Pre-Construction

- Historic application and meeting
- Secure building permit
- Deliver dumpster and storage container

Exterior Work

- Remove all siding and trim
- Repair all damaged and/or rotted areas on exterior of the house
- R&R as needed on corbels and details.
- Repair all soffit and fascia details
- Install house wrap
- Install Azek corner boards, window/door trim and miscellaneous trim
- Install pre-primed cedar clapboard siding.







Install all new gutters.

Additional Work

- Prep, prime with 1 coat and paint 2 coats the exterior with Sherwin Williams Duration latex paint
- Prep, prime and paint decks & front porch with Sherwin Williams Deck Paint
- Inspect the roof and make necessary repairs. (Additional cost if needed)
- Install historically correct replacement windows

- Sherwin Williams Duration latex paint.
- Sherwin Williams alkyd prime.
- Pre-Primed Cedar Clapboards.
- Azek Trim Boards.
- New Construction Historically Approved Windows.
- Stainless Steel Fasteners.
