PRENTISS STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

On Monday, June 6, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp, will plant new trees on Prentiss St, between Massachusetts Ave and the Somerville line. In the upcoming weeks, crews will also perform minor repairs at select locations and perform final roadway paving on Prentiss St from Massachusetts Ave to Oxford St. A paving date is not scheduled at this time.

Project Schedule

- Tree plantings will take place during the week of June 6.
- Minor repair work will take place starting the week of June 13 at select locations.
- Prentiss St paving from Mass Ave to Oxford St will take place later this month; an additional paving notice will follow once the date is scheduled.
- Work hours are 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.

What to Expect during Construction

- Prentiss St will remain open during the tree plantings and repair work.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Pedestrian and vehicle access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
