APPLETON STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Sewer work begins Tuesday, September 6

Dear Appleton Street Neighbor,

As you know, the city's contractor, P Gioioso & Sons, has been working on pre-construction activities on Appleton St. On **Tuesday, September 6**, crews will begin sewer upgrades on Appleton St, between Highland St and Brattle St. We expect this phase of the construction to take about 3 weeks to complete. Crews will then begin the water upgrades once the sewer work is finished.

What to Expect during Sewer Work

- Crews will begin sewer work on Tuesday, September 6.
- Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday (no work Monday, September 5).
- During work hours, Appleton St will be closed to through traffic but open to abutters, via intermittent detours.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Pedestrian access and access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways. All sidewalks will remain open.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times and all city services will continue.
