

NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ON LINNAEAN STREET

Dear Linnaean Street Neighbor,

The City awarded a contract for the reconstruction of a number of streets throughout Cambridge to DeFelice Corporation, which includes the following work on *Linnaean St*:

Drainage Improvements: Crews will install several new catch basins on Linnaean St.

Pedestrian Ramp Reconstruction: New pedestrian ramps will be placed throughout the project area.

Roadway Paving: The roadway will be repaved and new pavement markings will be installed.

The Community Development Department hosted several neighborhood meetings and developed pedestrian safety improvements including:

- Mid-block curb extension on Linnaean St for the existing crosswalk at the school.
- Curb extension and new crosswalk across Linnaean St at Avon Hill St.
- Curb extension and new crosswalk across Linnaean St at the intersection of Washington Ave.
- New curb extensions and crosswalks across Linnaean St at Agassiz St.

Schedule

The improvements listed above will take place in several phases. The contractor will mobilize on Linnaean St starting the week of **December 5** to install new catch basins. This work is expected to take 2 weeks to complete. The contractor will return in the spring to install new pedestrian ramps and curb extensions, and perform roadway paving. We will continue to update the neighbors as the construction progresses.

General work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday-Friday. "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
