ROADWAY GRINDING

LINNAEAN STREET & EXETER PARK

As part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, DeFelice Corp., will grind the surface of the roadway on Linnaean St (from Raymond St to Massachusetts Ave.) and Exeter Park on Thursday, August 30th and Friday, August 31st, to prepare the street for paving. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, and Linnaean St will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters. We expect the work to take 2 days to complete.

What to Expect During Roadway Grinding

- The road will be closed to through traffic during work hours, and reopened at the end of the work day.
- > Access to properties will be maintained, and all sidewalks will remain open.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- > Final paving will be scheduled for approximately one week later. An additional notice confirming the paving date will follow.
