NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ON SPRING STREET

Construction begins week of February 13

Dear Spring Street Neighbor,

The City awarded a contract for the reconstruction of a number of streets throughout Cambridge to DeFelice Corporation which includes the following work on Spring St:

New Water Main: The Cambridge Water Department has already installed new water main from Fulkerson St to Sixth St. DeFelice will install the remaining section of water main from Sixth St to Third St this winter.

Sidewalk Reconstruction: In the spring, crews will demolish existing sidewalks, remove and reset granite curbing, and place new sidewalks, driveways and curb ramps on Spring St from Fulkerson St to Third St.

Roadway Paving: The roadway will be repaved and new pavement markings will be installed.

The Community Development Department hosted several neighborhood meetings and developed a series of **traffic** calming improvements for Spring St including:

- Raised intersection at Spring St and Fulkerson St adjacent to the Kennedy-Longfellow School.
- Raised crosswalk and curb extensions on Spring St at Sixth St.
- Curb extensions on Spring St at Eighth St, Fifth St and Sciarappa St.

Schedule

During the week of **February 13**, DeFelice will mobilize on Spring St to begin installing the new water main and catch basins. Crews will start on Spring St at Third St and work their way towards Sixth St. We expect the work to take 1-2 months to complete. Surface improvements will take place in the spring. General work hours will be 7AM to 4 PM, Monday-Friday. "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
