

## **HURLBUT STREET CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

Drainage Work Begins Week of December 27

Dear Neighbor,

During the week of December 27 (weather permitting), the city's contractor, Newport Construction, will mobilize on Hurlbut St to install new catch basins. We expect the work to take about 1-2 weeks to complete.

## **PROJECT SCHEDULE**

- On Tuesday, December 27, crews will mobilize on Hurlbut St (weather permitting). The drainage work is expected to take 1-2 weeks to complete.
- Once crews complete the drainage work they will demobilize from the area. In the spring, crews will return to reconstruct sidewalks and pedestrian ramps, install new crosswalks, and pave the roadway on Hurlbut St.
- Please note that crews will not work on Monday, December 26 or Monday, January 2.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- General work hours will be 7AM to 4 PM, Monday-Friday (except holidays noted above).
- "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
