HURLBUT STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction Resumes Monday, April 3

Dear Hurlbut St Neighbor,

On **Monday, April 3** (weather permitting), the city's contractor, Newport Construction, will mobilize on Hurlbut St to resume construction activities. The remaining work includes lead water service replacement (not all properties), sidewalk reconstruction and roadway paving. We expect the work to take about 1 month to complete.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- On Monday, April 3, crews will mobilize on Hurlbut St (weather permitting).
- Crews will first replace lead water services as determined by the Cambridge Water Department. Properties requiring service replacement will receive a separate notice from the Water Department.
- Once crews complete the water work they will reconstruct sidewalks, pedestrian ramps, and repave the roadway.
- We expect the work to take about 1 month to complete, weather permitting.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- General work hours will be 7AM to 4 PM, Monday-Friday.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
