



Conceptual Design Discussion: CH 90, Contract 24











GOALS

- De-pave (Increase perviousness/infiltration)
- Improved water quality by reducing stormwater runoff
- Meet requirements of the City's EPA Stormwater Permit
 - requires efforts to improve water quality in the Alewife Brook and Charles River. This area drains to the Alewife Brook. Reducing impervious surfaces and improving infiltration of stormwater helps us meet those requirements.

- Utilize native species
 - Visually connect to FPR
 - Maximize canopy
- Reduce urban heat island impacts by absorbing heat and creating shade
- Increased curb appeal
- Create focused "Memorial" spaces
- Reduce vehicle/pedestrian conflicts







Proposed Planting – Canopy Trees

- 1. Quercus rubra (red oak)
- 2. Carya ovata (shagbark hickory)
- 3. Acer rubrum (red maple)
- **4.** *Pinus strobus* (white pine)
- 5. Nyssa sylvatica (tupelo)
- **6.** *Tilia americana* (Basswood)







Proposed Planting – Understory Trees & Shrubs

- 1. Quercus velutina (yellow birch)
- **2.** Cornus florida (flowering dogwood)
- 3. Amelanchier x grandiflora (serviceberry)
- **4.** Ostrya virginiana (hophornbeam)









Proposed Planting – Woodland Edge

- Clethra alnifolia (summersweet)
- **2.** Lindera benzoin (spicebush)
- 3. Osmundastrum cinnamomeum (cinnamon fern)
- **4.** Fothergilla gardenii (dwarf fothergilla)









Proposed Planting – Groundcovers

- 1. Schizachyrium scoparium (little bluestem)
- 2. Tiarella cordifolia (foamflower)
- Asarum canadense (Canadian wild ginger)
- **4.** Eurybia divaricata (white wood aster)
- Eragrostis spectabilis (purple lovegrass)














De-Paving Summary
