The City Hall Entry Accessibility Upgrades project is part of a larger City of Cambridge capital plan and is intended to improve accessibility at this heavily used public building, incorporating universal design principals including wayfinding.

Public comments received at Community Meeting #1 include the following:

- 1. A holistic approach to proposed work at the Annex e.g. recent bike parking installation conflicting with universal accessible design at the entrance.
- 2. Impact of walkway and stair to Animal Control entrance on snow removal at the parking lot
- 3. Storm water drainage at the parking lot
- 4. Compare the existing conditions prior to the previous certified LEED Gold alteration to the post-development conditions proposed by this project.
- 5. Stair rail at West Place entrance requires repair
- 6. Plant selection at rain garden
- 7. Existing shortcut to front entrance from parking lot
- 8. Convenience of consolidated bike parking compared to multiple bike parking locations
- 9. Opportunities to further increase of pervious areas
- 10. Update presentation to include site lighting, with focus on consistent light levels along walkway

A subsequent meeting was requested by Community Members to review the prior site design and compare to current conditions and the proposed design.
