SMITH PLACE ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Starts Monday, October 31

Dear Resident or Business,

On **Monday October 31**, the City's contractor, C.J. Mabardy, Inc. will begin reconstructing the roadway on Smith Place from the north edge of Concord Ave to the Burger King drive through exit (approximately 75 feet), due to the subsurface conditions.

While under construction, this section of Smith Place will be closed to traffic and vehicle traffic will need to access Smith Place via Moulton St and Wilson Road.

We expect the work to be completed within one week. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM. Smith Place will be reopened as soon as is possible.
