

# Fawcett Street Construction Starts Mid-December

Dear Fawcett Street Neighbor,

The City of Cambridge has awarded a contract for the reconstruction of Fawcett Street to the D'Allessandro Corp, who will begin to mobilize in mid to late December. Construction is anticipated to be completed in the Spring 2014.

## Project Scope

The reconstruction of Fawcett Street between Concord Avenue and Smith Place will include:

- New sidewalks and pedestrian ramps along the entire length of Fawcett Street to improve pedestrian mobility and safety.
- New street paving.
- Elements to enhance the visual character of Fawcett St and to improve the quality of the water discharged to the Alewife Brook.
  - New street trees.
  - Landscaped areas, including bio-retention areas.
  - Pervious asphalt.
- Improvements to the drainage and sanitary sewer systems and a new 12" water main.

### What to expect during construction

- General work hours will be 7am 4pm, Monday thru Friday. If any night or weekend work is required by the contractor, you will be notified with a separate notice.
- If the project requires a street closure, you will be notified in advance.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents and businesses.
