

ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION ON PLYMPTON AND LINDEN STREETS

Plympton Street: Tuesday, July 5 and Wednesday, July 6 Linden Street: Thursday, July 7 and Friday, July 8

During the week of July 5 as part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will begin reconstructing the surface of the roadway on Plympton St and Linden St, to prepare the streets for paving.

Crews will perform roadway construction on Plympton St on Tuesday, July 5 and Wednesday, July 6 and on Linden St on Thursday, July 7 and Friday, July 8.

What to Expect During Roadway Reconstruction

- Plympton St will be closed on Tuesday and Wednesday during the work hours of 7 AM to 4 PM, and reopened and the end of the work day. Linden St will be closed on Thursday and Friday from 7 AM to 4 PM, and reopened at the end of the work day.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- > Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving on both streets is tentatively scheduled for the week of July 11. An additional notice confirming the paving date will follow.
