MBTA Harvard Square Station Vertical Improvements Project

SCHEDULE UPDATE:

Construction on the MBTA Harvard Square Station Vertical Improvements Project has been extended through the summer due to issues related to the elevator design. While the plaza has been reopened to the public, work will continue on the elevator façade underground, within the station. The new elevator will now feature a glass façade instead of a stainless steel within the elevator head house to provide maximum visibility.

JF White, the MBTA's contractor, will perform installation of the glass façade and additional punch list items over the next few months. The MBTA anticipates the elevator to be fully operational in early fall.
