MYRTLE/MAGNOLIA CONSTRUCTION PROJECT UPDATE

Dear Myrtle/Magnolia Neighbor,

During the month of August, the City's Contractor, D'Allessandro Corporation, has made great progress on the Myrtle/Magnolia Project. In early July, crews completed the pulverizing and binder paving on **Hovey Avenue**. The contractor is currently performing sidewalk work on the west side (opposite of Spaulding Hospital) of the avenue. Crews are expected to complete the sidewalks on Hovey Avenue in mid to late September.



On **Myrtle Avenue**, crews have little sidewalk work that remains, and that sidewalk work is expected to be completed by mid-September. Sidewalks on **Magnolia Avenue** have already been reconstructed and crews will be completing the final paving of the roadway in Fall 2013. We continue to ask that any residents and visitors of Magnolia Avenue and Myrtle Avenue open their vehicle door with caution, as the curbs are higher than normal until the final paving is complete. **Lamont Avenue** will have final paving placed in Fall 2013. During the week of August 12, crews installed the landmark Julia Child's "Bon Appetite" signature at Savenor's Butcher and Market on **Kirkland Street**.
