RICHARD AVE & MULLER AVE CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Construction Begins Week of December 5

Dear Neighbor,

During the week of December 5, the city's contractor, Newport Construction, will mobilize on Richard Ave, Muller Ave and Murray Hill Rd to install new catch basins. We expect the work to take about 1-2 weeks to complete.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- During the week of December 5, crews will mobilize in the Richard/Muller Ave neighborhood, weather permitting. The drainage work is expected to take 1-2 weeks to complete.
- Once crews complete the drainage work they will demobilize from the area. In the spring, crews will return to reconstruct sidewalks, install new crosswalks, and pave the roadway on Richard Ave and Muller Ave. Crews will also finish the remaining section of sidewalk on Murray Hill Rd, between Muller Ave and Matignon Rd.
- We will continue to provide updates as the construction progresses.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- General work hours will be 7AM to 4 PM, Monday-Friday.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
