

Underground Electric Distribution Upgrade

Dear Neighbor,

As part of our continued effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers and communities, we want to let you know that Eversource and its approved contractor plan to begin installation of new underground vaults and duct banks (a group of tubes to house electric lines) on **Prospect Street, Harvard Street, and Portland Street in Somerville and Cambridge** over the coming weeks in support of an electric distribution upgrade. The project will connect the Prospect Street Substation in Somerville to an existing distribution network in Cambridge.

This work will not interrupt your electric service.



Construction Work typically occurs Monday through Saturday 7 AM to 4 PM

- Excavating and installing prefabricated underground vaults
- Excavating a trench in the street to accommodate duct bank and cable installation
- Removal of soils from the site, using dump trucks and excavators
- Temporary use of steel road plates to safely secure the area at the end of each day
- Backfilling and temporary restoration once the duct bank is installed



Traffic Management

Eversource coordinates closely with municipal officials on effective traffic management. At times, parking restrictions may be necessary and will be clearly posted in advance. Construction crews will occupy a portion of the roadway, typically leaving the remainder of the road passable to motorists.




