Criteria and goals for percent-for-art projects:

1. Responsive to the Foundry's Vision and Mission:

- a. Vision: A space for ongoing creativity and collaboration by members of all ages in the Cambridge community.
- b. Mission: Bringing together arts, cultural expression, technology, and education.
- 2. Artistic Excellence: High level of artistic excellence

3. Accessible and Culturally Sensitive:

- a. Holds the potential to attract and speak to anyone, regardless of background, experience, education, or age
- b. Accessible to broad range of learning styles and abilities
- c. Sensitive to the multicultural richness of the Cambridge community

4. Collaborative and Participatory Design Process:

- a. Design process is collaborative and integrated with new architecture and historic value of the building
- b. Design process invites participation from future users of the Foundry, including individuals, organizations, or other artists
- 5. **Experienced:** Artist has a record of community engagement; experience successfully executing public art projects

6. **Enduring:**

- a. Sustains interest in visitor experience, from a short visit to extended and/or daily encounter
- b. Physical presence allows for future uses of the Foundry space, e.g. avoids occupying a large singular amount of space that might be desired for future creations.
- 7. **Inspirational:** Inspires the creativity of others; informed by a spirit of play or inventiveness
- 8. Feasible: Appropriate to the budget and municipal maintenance capacity
