### 6:15 3. Commercial PACE

Speaker: John DiModica, Director of Rhode Island C-PACE

*Objective:* The Legislature authorized the creation of a commercial Property Assessed Clean Energy (C-PACE) program through MassDevelopment as part of the energy bill enacted this summer. Once the program is set up, commercial properties, including multifamily buildings with 5 or more units, will be eligible for financing for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects that will be administered through the property tax system for municipalities that opt in. John DiModica runs the Rhode Island C-PACE program and will discuss how it works, what the benefits are, and lessons learned to begin the process of understanding if this makes sense for Cambridge.
