III. Cambridge Riverfront Planning Study

- 4. Goals: places to linger, places to gather, improved access.
- 5. Recommendations:
 - a. Improvements along DCR-owned river frontage—benches, kiosks, trees, look-outs.
 - b. Maintain/enhance tree canopy
 - c. Encourage welcoming/active ground floor uses along the waterfront
 - d. Improve pedestrian flow to river
 - e. Improve bicycle flow to and along river
 - f. Analyze feasibility of additional boat access
 - g. Support regular events/activities that bring people to the river
