Tour with City Arborist

The city arborist is looking to set up a small tour for bicyclist to look at some of the city's trees. If successful this could become a published self guided tour like the walking tours.

Bicycle Parking Zoning Petition

No further progress at this point it has been held up in the City Council.

Concord Ave Project

There will be a joint pedestrian and bicycle committee meeting 5/20.

Harvard Square Plaza and Jughandle

Question about the signage in Harvard Plaza was raised, some people have encountered pedestrians upset to see people biking in that location, even though that is allowed. Also the committee discussed what to do about the current jughandle at the intersection of Mass Ave and Church that allows bikes a place to pull over before making a turn onto Church St. The current island design encroaches on the bike lane making it harder for bikes that want to go straight but the committee raised concerns about deleting the island that forms the jughandle for fear it would become a place that cars pull over. The committee generally recommended making the island narrower as a compromise.
