#### Right turn on red for bikes

- Patrick from the Traffic Dept attended to seek input on recommended locations
- There are currently 3 marked as such in Kendall Sq. They had a red arrow when it was green to go straight, and this blocked up the bike lane for bikes wanting to go straight when those turning right had to stop.
- Want to focus on major traffic areas, not every small street intersection in the city...
- Ideas for RTOR
  - Inman St in Central Sq during Ped crossings
  - o Proposed rule: any intersection with dedicated ped crossing interval?
  - Proposed rule: all turns from street into a street with a standard bike lane or a separated bike lane? Eg. all streets entering South Mass Ave
  - Proposed rule: look more closely at wayfinding routes to apply RTOR where possible
  - Mt. Auburn east at Putnam Ave.
  - Mt. Auburn and DeWolfe RTOR might not work but a bike light at would allow turns during Ped interval
  - Portland at Bway, both ways
  - Highland Ave onto Cambridge St
  - Brattle onto Fayerweather
  - Fayerweather onto Brattle
