

## RIVER STREET RECONSTRUCTION

## **WORKING GROUP MEETING: TUESDAY JANUARY 29**

The River Street Reconstruction project will upgrade the subsurface infrastructure and develop a new and improved street design for River Street, including Carl Barron Plaza and the bus terminal area near the junction of River, Green, and Magazine Streets.

The River Street Reconstruction Working Group will meet monthly, with some exceptions for months when public meetings are held. All Working Group meetings are open to the public.

At this first Working Group meeting, City and design team staff and Working Group members will be introduced for the first time, and together they will discuss the group's role, review relevant City policies and prior planning efforts, and build an understanding of the project scope and timeline.
