The River Street Reconstruction Project will upgrade the subsurface infrastructure while developing a new surface design for River Street, the bus terminal area at River and Magazine Streets near Central Square, and Carl Barron Plaza. Meetings are occurring monthly. Working Group meetings are open to the public.

At this meeting Working Group members will discuss public input on the existing conditions, refine project goals, and identify design challenges. The City will introduce a toolbox of potential design elements and provide a brief preview of the Carl Barron Plaza charrette process to begin in May.
