Special Permit waive the setback requirements for 20 residential units with ground floor retail and 20 parking spaces below grade as permitted in the Harvard Square Overlay District, Section 20.54.5.1. Brighton Allston Properties, LLC/R&R Realty LLC, applicants.

Request a reduction in the number of parking spaces for the housing and office/research and development space in the One Leighton Street building and the Maple Leaf building and any subsequent development authorized originally by Special Permit #175. This is the second public hearing for the Major Amendment as required by the provisions of Section 12.37. The applicant is requesting the Planning Board to amend the special permit to allow a reduction in required parking as normally granted by the Board of Zoning Appeal, Section 6.35.1, but which may be issued by the Planning Board as authorized in Section10.45. Archstone (formerly known as Archstone-Smith Operating Trust) and ASN Maple Leaf (Office) LLC, applicants.
