The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 10, 2011at 7:20 p.m. in the Second Floor Meeting Room at City Hall Annex, 344 Broadway, Cambridge, Massachusetts on a zoning petition by the Cambridge City Council, to amend Sections of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Cambridge relating to the Conversion of Nonresidential Structures to Residential Use. The proposed amendments are as follows:

Article 4.000: Addition of a new Section 4.29 clarifying the allowance of additional uses not specified in the Table of Use Regulations for Conversion of Non-Residential Structures to Residential Use, as permissible under Section 5.28.2 by Planning Board Special Permit.

Section 5.28.2 – Conversion of Non-Residential Structures to Residential Use (permissible by Planning Board Special Permit): Modifications to existing zoning language in relation to the scope and intent of the Section; Allowed Gross Floor Area; Allowed Uses; Dwelling Units; Private Open Space Requirements; Required Parking; Criteria for Approval of a Special Permit.

Article 6.000: Addition of a new Section 6.35.3 defining a "Parking Analysis," which would be required to be undertaken for specific projects, including some projects permissible under Section 5.28.2; modification to Section 6.35.1 relating to Reduction of Required Parking.
