About the PB Cambridge Steering Committee

The Steering Committee (SC) **oversees the PB process** and works with City Staff to ensure that PB Cambridge is transparent, fair and inclusive. It is comprised of community members, support organizations, key experts, and residents.

Member Responsibilities

Members serve throughout the PB cycle (Nov-April) by:

- Promoting PB in their organization and at community events
- Overseeing the PB Cambridge process by reviewing the rulebook (Nov)
- Volunteering for assemblies (Dec) and voting sites (March), or recruiting volunteers to meet these requirements
- Serving as facilitators or liaisons to Budget Delegate committees (Jan-Feb)
- Attending monthly committee meetings (Nov-April)

SC members **should not miss more than 3 SC meetings**. Organizations should nominate an alternate representative to attend meetings if and when the primary representative is unavailable.
