The existing commercial building entries remain along the JFK and Winthrop Street elevations. The new Residential Entrance Lobby (90 Winthrop Street) is located on Winthrop Street adjacent to the alley and 96 Winthrop Street. An elevator takes residents directly up to level 3 where they arrive at the Residential Lobby and Deck which overtook the park. The 42 residential units are planned out along a "U" shaped double loaded corridor. This maximizes the number of park and street facing apartments. In the center of the "U" is a light court which provides natural light and air to the non-street facing units. The buildings mechanical units are mostly relocated above a portion of the Alley with the remainder screened on the roof, in the western corner, adjacent to the existing public parking garage.
