 - b. Private projects: E&R Laundry adaptive reuse (Novartis); alterations to Gerald Chen properties, including 115 Mt. Auburn St. and 39 JFK Street; Twining Properties redevelopment of Quest Pharmaceuticals properties at Lafayette Square; Alexandria Corp. adaptive reuse of former New England Maple Syrup Co. building at Second and Linsky Way; affordable housing project at 1791 Massachusetts Avenue; adaptive reuse of 893-907 Main Street (Toscannini's) as hotel; Spee Club accessibility; Cambridge Gas-Light Co. building, 719 Mass. VI. National Register/Preservation Planning.

- 1. Orchard Street NRD. This nomination will be finalized as staff becomes available.
- 2. Harvard 106 agreement. No developments.
- 3. MIT 106 agreement. No developments.
- 4. Digitizing Inventory. The Commission's inventory of all 13,000 buildings in Cambridge exists only in paper form and occupies 31 file drawers. We have a \$30,000 CPA appropriation on hand. We are designing a demonstration project with input from Cambridge assessing and GIS departments and digitizing survey files for a single block in East Cambridge. Cambridge's IT Department is supporting up to \$8,000 in costs for a jointly-selected consultant to advance the project.

VII. Publications

- **1.** *Building Old Cambridge.* Four thousand copies were printed; as of May 26, 1,544 had left the warehouse, and net sales totaled \$41,279.
- 2. Oral history publications. We are considering reprinting *Crossroads: Stories of Central Square* (2001), and *Cambridge City Hall* (1990), which have gone out of print.
- 3. *Cambridge Street Names*. Volunteer Michael Kenney has updated a catalogue of city streets originally compiled by City Engineer Lewis Hastings in the 19th century. Publication is awaiting the new CHC website.
- 4. *Cambridge Mayors*. Kit and Michael Kenney are preparing longer biographies of the mayors and other city officials whose portraits hang in City Hall. These will be published as a booklet.

- 1. Survey Files Database Project. Meeting with Paul Cote, GIS contractor for our project. On 6/6 the project kickoff meeting discussed naming conventions and workflows for digitized files. On 6/19 Paul and Meta Partenheimer, CHC digitization assistant, met regarding PDF formatting, naming conventions and creating/running a script for geolocation.
- 2. Office Reorganization & Collection Preservation. Meta finished inventories and finding aids for several existing collections; all will be posted online.
