  - L-121: Harvard Square Kiosk (11/3/17). City of Cambridge, owner. The City Manager has appointed a 17-member committee to oversee improvements to the kiosk and the plaza. The Planning Board had no comments and the report will be sent to the City Council shortly.
  - L-122: 101 Rogers St., Foundry Building (1/5/2018). The CRA has initiated a new process, beginning 7/12 with a CHC staff presentation. A City Council roundtable discussion on July 26 took no issue with potential landmarking.
  - L-124: 227 Cambridge St., Lechmere National Bank (12/1/17). See agenda.
  - L-126: 40 Cottage Street. (2/2/2018). Alterations approved 10/5. No developments.
  - L-127: 44 Cottage Street. (2/2/2018). No developments.

  - L-110: 37 Brookline St. fence. Designation request tabled. Sarah Burks has been consulting with the owner and the Arts Council about ways to recognize the fence.

#### VI. National Register/Preservation Planning.

- 1. Orchard Street NRD. This nomination will be finalized as staff becomes available.
- 2. Harvard 106 agreement. No developments.
- 3. MIT 106 agreement. No developments.
- 4. Digitizing Inventory. The Commission's inventory of all 13,000 buildings in Cambridge exists only in paper form and occupies 31 file drawers. We have a \$30,000 CPA appropriation on hand. We are designing a demonstration project with input from Cambridge assessing and GIS departments and digitizing survey files for a single block in East Cambridge. Cambridge's IT Department is supporting up to \$8,000 in costs for a jointly-selected consultant to advance the project. The next step is a beta project to allow us to test the consultant's model.

#### VII. Publications

- 1. Building Old Cambridge. Four thousand copies were printed; as of Nov. 30, 1,680 had left the warehouse, and net sales totaled \$44,938. The index has been digitized and made available on the internet.
- 2. Oral history publications. We are considering reprinting *Crossroads: Stories of Central Square* (2001), and *Cambridge City Hall* (1990), which have gone out of print.
- 3. Cambridge Street Names. Volunteer Michael Kenney has updated a catalogue of city streets originally compiled by City Engineer Lewis Hastings in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Michael is perfecting the draft before we post it to the new CHC website.

- 4. *Cambridge Mayors*. Kit and Michael Kenney are preparing longer biographies of the mayors and other city officials whose portraits hang in City Hall. These will be published as a booklet.
- 5. *The Long-Ago Squadrons of Cambridge*. Michael Kenny has written up his research on this archaic term used to describe land divisions in 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> century Massachusetts (see *Building Old Cambridge*, pp. 273-274; posted at <a href="http://www.cambridgema.gov/historic/cambridgehistory">http://www.cambridgema.gov/historic/cambridgehistory</a>)
- 6. Out of print publications. The MIT Press is exploring the possibility of digitizing *Report Two: Mid Cambridge* (1967), *Report Five: Northwest Cambridge* (1977), and *East Cambridge* (1988) and releasing them as open access PDFs to be hosted on archive.org.

#### VIII. Archives and Collections (Emily Gonzalez)

- 1. Survey Files Database Project: Met with consultant Paul Cote and team for an Omeka training session. Charlie, Paul and GIS staff members met to discuss storing Omeka on the Azure Cloud. Next steps also include updating a building file item types glossary.
- 2. Library: Archives Assistant Emily Magagnosc and Rachel Nicolosi, our Simmons archives intern, have continued adding call numbers to our library books and physically reorganizing the stacks.
- 3. Collections: Meta Partenheimer, digitization assistant, added items to the Omeka building file item types glossary, and processed the collection of Boston Globe newspaper clippings. These will be available online soon. New volunteer Kathleen Fox is cataloguing our recently donated E.F. Bowker collection of surveyors' papers and plans. Rachel Nicolosi began working on reorganizing correspondence in the Ellis & Andrews collection.
- 4. Social Media Outreach: Weekly Instagram posts and semi-weekly blog posts, highlighting new collections and newly digitized items.
- 5. Additional Activities: Hosted an "open archive" event for city employees; the theme was municipal buildings. Along with Emily Magagnosc and Meta Partenheimer, filmed a short series of vignettes on our archives for CCTV. Participated in several weeks of enterprise (electronic) content management vendor interviews as part of the City's document management working group. A final decision was made by the working group leader to eliminate all of the vendors from the running; unclear when the process will begin again. Met with new Cambridge Historical Society archivist Maggie Hoffman and attended CHS collections committee meeting. Created a guide to writing processing plans for archival collections. Brought some of our collections items to NEDCC for repair, and took a tour of the facilities.

The post-1923 Chronicle is password-protected because of copyright issues.

#### X. Capital Projects

- 1. Bronze maintenance. All municipal bronze plaques and statues are repatinated periodically. Weathering has been minimal so we keep postponing from year to year.
- 2. Old Burying Ground. Fannin\Lehrner Associates resumed work on headstones on May 30, and Dario Fiorentini has completed restoration of the long brick tomb and a table tomb that had to

- 10. Dog Parks Committee (Sarah Burks). We resist efforts to officially sanction dog use at Longfellow Park.
- 11. Digital permits. The Energov online building permit system requires a major commitment from both Sarah and Sam, limiting staff time for other activities.

- 16. African American Trail. In FY2016, the City Council appropriated money to the Commission for expansion of the African American Heritage Trail. We hired Christle Rawlins-Jackson as project consultant; she has met with the Heritage Trail Alliance and staff at the commission and the historical society, and is compiling an initial list of possible new marker subjects.
- 17. Solar policy. CDD staff and consultants have advised on a solar installation policy that staff will recommend for adoption by all commissions.
- 18. Preservation Awards. The Harvard Lampoon received a Massachusetts Historical Commission historic preservation award for their recent project, which the CHC recognized last year.
