- 9. Dixon Bros. hardware, Brattle Street
- 10. Brines Block, Brattle Street
- 11. 1-8 Brattle Street
- 12. Read Block (landmark; pre-dates HSCD)
- 13. 18-24 JFK Street
- 14. Abbot Building, Corcoran's, corner of Brattle and JFK streets

Sarah Burks, Preservation Planner at the CHC, answered questions about the sign regulations of the zoning code and HSCD.
