Fayerweather St. (Concord to Copley) <u>Drain Lining</u> Wednesday, February 10th, 2016

Dear Residents,

As part of the work to complete the sewer separation in your neighborhood under the **Concord Ave - Alewife Sewer Separation Project**, the City will be lining the drain main on Fayerweather Street on Wednesday, February 10th (weather permitting), beginning at 7am. This lining will provide a new, jointless drain pipe that minimizes root and water infiltration problems, improves flow, and provides for a more structurally sound pipe without the need for excavation.

What to Expect During Drain Lining:

- Construction hours begin at 7am and may extend into the evening.
- Set up of equipment may cause some adjustments in parking. Please pay attention to posted "**No Parking**" signs.
- Set of equipment may cause some adjustments to traffic patterns.
- During certain phases of the operation, you may detect an odor.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways of entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to all properties at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
