## MYRTLE/MAGNOLIA CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

On Monday, March 26, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corporation, will begin sewer main installation on Magnolia Ave. During this work, Magnolia Ave will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters.

## Project Schedule

- Crews will begin to mobilize on Magnolia Ave on Thursday, March 22.
- Sewer installation on Magnolia Ave is expected to take 3-4 weeks to complete.
- Once crews complete the sewer work on Magnolia Ave, they will move to Lamont Ave, then Hovey St.
- Work hours are 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.

## What to Expect during Construction

- During this work, Magnolia Ave will be closed to through traffic but open to abutters.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times and all city services will continue.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times. Traffic signs and police details will be in place to assist neighbors.
- Pedestrian access and access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways. All sidewalks will remain open.
