

WESTERN AVENUE – CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

During the month of October, the City's Contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., remained focused on the sidewalk and roadway restoration phase of the Western Avenue Reconstruction Project.

Completed:

• The contractor has completed the reconstruction of the sidewalks on the south side of Western Avenue.

Current & Upcoming Activities:

 Beginning the Thursday, October 23 (weather permitting), crews will be reconstructing the sidewalks on the north side of Western Avenue between Riverside Place and Memorial Drive. While crews work near the Memorial Drive intersection, Western Avenue will be reduced to 2 lanes of travel during general work hours (7am-4pm, Monday through Friday). This work is expected to be completed within 2 weeks.



- Crews are currently performing sidewalk reconstruction on the north side of Western Avenue between Soden Street and Dodge Street.
- The contractor has completed the installation of the decorative street lights on Western Avenue and is currently working with NStar Electric to energize the new lights.
- Before the contractor reduces the number of crews for the winter season, every effort is being made to complete the new cycle track from Pleasant Street to Memorial Drive.
