# Community Meeting Ames Street Land Disposition

**Background** The City has proposed selling a 20-foot wide strip of public land along the eastern edge of Ames Street between Main Street and Broadway in Kendall Square (see map on reverse). The land would be sold to a private owner with the condition that it would be combined with adjacent land to enable the construction of a residential building with ground floor retail.

This will be a follow-up to the community meeting held on October 23. It will be followed by a Planning Board meeting at which there will be a public hearing on a rezoning petition for this section of Ames Street that would be necessary to enable the proposed residential development.

**Process** The City's Municipal Ordinance, Section 2.110.010, requires that a public process be conducted before public land may be sold ("land disposition"). Following this community meeting, a report will be prepared and sent to the City Council. Then, public hearings will be conducted at the Planning Board and City Council. A City Council vote will be required in order to approve a land disposition agreement.

State laws (Chapter 30B) also require that when land is disposed, proposals must be solicited from all interested buyers before selecting a final buyer. The City has issued a Request for Proposals, which will be discussed in more detail at the meeting. **Proposals are due at 10:00am on Friday, November 8, 2013.** Information is available from the City's Purchasing Department.
