

CAMBRIDGE NEIGHBORHOOD DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE TABLE OF CONTENTS

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INTRODUCTION

The tables included in this document provide several key indicators of neighborhood change over the past two decades.

Data Sources

The data in the tables derives from U. S. Census Bureau as follows:


- 1980 data from the Neighborhood Census Program
- 1990 data from the User Defined Areas Program
- 2000 data from either the SF1 data file compiled from the results of the Census short form or from a Special Tabulation compiled for the Community Development Department.

User Notes

The neighborhood census tables provided here should be used with the following precautions:

- Variations in Information: The figures found in the tables may differ from other information available from the US Census, the Community Development Department or other sources. This disparity arises from sampling variability between the US Census Long Form and Short Form survey instruments. The US Census used the Long Form instrument to collect the data used in the neighborhood census tables. The Long Form does not produce a true census, since it is mailed to one in six households. The US Census Bureau extrapolates Long Form data to apply it to the entire population. On the other hand, the Short Form instrument is mailed to all households and collects some of the same data as the Long Form from the entire population (e. g., population, age, race, etc.). Where information is available from both forms, the Short Form is regarded as the more accurate source. In other words, where a conflict occurs between data from the two forms, the US Census Bureau recommends the use of "100% count" data.
- Rounding Error: Much of the 2000 neighborhood level information was computed by using ratios drawn from a Special Census Tabulation compiled for the Community Development Department by the Census Bureau. As a result, in certain instances subcategory figures do not sum to the neighborhood total. In addition, neighborhood totals may fail to sum to the 2000 citywide figures, which are drawn directly from the SF3 data file for the City of Cambridge.
- Boundary Adjustments: Comparisons of 1980, 1990 and 2000 information is complicated by changes in US Census boundaries, Census Bureau data suppression policies and data compilation errors. All statistical tables reflect the following adjustments:

- If necessary, the US Census Bureau will suppress data to protect individual privacy in areas whose population falls below a certain threshold. In accordance with this policy, in 1980 Cambridge Highlands expanded to include a portion of Area 9. This measure affected the blocks bounded by Bellis Circle, Walden Street, Garden Street, Field Street, Bay State Road and the Fitchburg Division railroad tracks. In 1990 data from this area was restored to Neighborhood 9.
- Changes to US Census Bureau technology for the 1990 Census required minor boundary adjustments between several neighborhoods. Small portions of blocks shifted between Cambridgeport (Area 5) and Riverside (Area 7), between Mid-Cambridge (Area 6) and Agassiz (Area 8), and between West Cambridge (Area 10) and Strawberry Hill (Area 13).
- In 1980 and 1990 Census Block boundaries did not allow for an accurate compilation of data for residents of Strawberry Hill (Area 13) living in homes east of Holworthy Street, Holworthy Place and Park Avenue and west of the Watertown Branch train tracks. Persons residing in this area were counted as residents of West Cambridge (Area 10). The 2000 Census counts these persons as residents of Strawberry Hill.
- In compiling results for the 2000 Census, the Census Bureau erroneously assigned the residents of Harvard University dormitories located in Harvard Yard and along Harvard Street east of Quincy Square, all of which fall in the Mid-Cambridge neighborhood, to a block located south of Massachusetts Avenue in the Riverside neighborhood. To compensate for this error, all residents of the block located south of Massachusetts Avenue are allocated to Mid-Cambridge for the purpose of calculating neighborhood statistics. The great majority of the persons affected are group quarters residents residing in Harvard University dormitories.
- The single census block surrounded by Huron Avenue, Grove Street, Blanchard Road, Concord Avenue and Fresh Pond Parkway, including Fresh Pond Reservation, falls partially in West Cambridge (Area 10), Cambridge Highlands (Area 12) and Strawberry Hill (Area 13). The Area 10 portion is unpopulated. To accommodate census block boundaries, the Area 12 portion is included in the Strawberry Hill figures for all three years analyzed.
