Dear Mayor's Summer Youth Employment Program Participant:

We are writing to make you aware of a moneymaking opportunity! Every winter many elderly and disabled residents of Cambridge need help shoveling snow. The Cambridge Council on Aging and the Office of Workforce Development has collaborated to solve this problem.

We are currently recruiting youth to shovel snow. Pay for shoveling will usually range from \$15 to \$30 per job, depending on the amount of snow and size of the area being shoveled. Homeowner's will contact you directly. *The pay is negotiated between you and the homeowner, and the homeowner will pay you directly.* It is suggested that you and the homeowner agree on a price *before* the job is done.
