Trick or Treating Tips



Young children should always be accompanied by an adult.



Older children should go out in groups of three or more and carry flashlights.



Have children go only to neighborhood houses or people they know. Adults should know their route and time of return.



Remind children to stay away from strangers and not to accept anything from them.



Review traffic safety rules with your children. Remind children to stay on sidewalks.



Costumes should be non-flammable, light in color, or add reflective tape, and shouldn't block vision.



Children should avoid carrying sharp objects.



Discard candy with loose or open wrappers.
