

## **Mayor Thomas W. Danehy Park Barbecue Area Permit**

The barbecue area is open to Cambridge residents from May 1st – November 1st.

A permit is required to use this area. The permit authorizes the use of the two charcoal grills and the seven picnic tables.

A. The permit fee is \$25. *Proof of Cambridge Residency will be required from the person seeking the permit.*

B. Permits are granted for the following four-hour time slots:

- 11am – 3pm or
- 4pm – 8pm

After Labor Day, Permits will be granted for the following four-hour time slot:

- 12pm – 4pm.

C. Permits can be obtained by any of the following methods:

Only match-lightable coals are allowed in the charcoal grills; the use of lighter fluid is not permitted. Danehy Park staff will dispose of the coals after each time slot.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is NOT permitted at Danehy Park.
