CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Good
morning. This is a meeting of the Pole and Conduit Comission, August 17, it is about 10:03 a. $m$ and we are in the Mi chael J. Lombardi Building, 831 Massachusetts Avenue, Basement Conference room

Do you have mintes to approve?
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I
make a motion to approve the mintes from the June 20 hearing.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Seconded.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I
in favor?
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Aye.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Is there any
resident here to speak on any of the petitions?
(Pause.)

ABBY ZANGER: I' m sorry. But I'm not
goi ng to speak agai nst. I' m goi ng to thank you
for conti nuing so could get information.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: We'll hear
it first so you can get out of here. Which
petition is that for?
(No response.)

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Which petition?

ABBY ZANGER: No. 2.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: So let's
call NSTAR.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

State your name for the record also.

St ate your name and please spell it as wel I.

ABBY ZANGER: Abby Zanger A-B- B- Y
Z- A- N- G- E-R.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Thank you.
And with NSTAR today?
KATIE FLAHERTY: Katie FI aherty, K-A-T-I-E F-L-A-H-E-R-T-Y.

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: Stephen, P-H, hasyla W-A-S-Y-L-A, J-R.

CONTI NUED PETI TI ON
EVERSOURCE - GROSVENOR ROAD
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
This petition was for Grove Street and this was continued from last month and this was at Grosvenor Road and northeasterly from manhole 2206, a distance of 10 feet of conduit. I bel ieve we continued this for my information from a request from the abutter and I thi nk we've -- I di d speak.

ABBY ZANGER: And that was great. I
really appreciate it.
I don't think the abutters on the other side have any clue about this because they've just bought the house. I just want to put that on the record.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yep.
ABBY ZANGER: I know it is not legal --
that you are not legally required to let them
know but they don't know.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So
you are satisfied with the explanation of the request about Eversource?

ABBY ZANGER: Yes. As it is not going to affect the del ivery of el ectricity to $m y$ house.

Ri ght, adding people on the Iine will not affect the service, $m$ service?

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: No.

ABBY ZANGER: Okay.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Okay. Make a motion to approve with typical conditions.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I
in favor?
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Aye.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Thank you.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Thank you.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: We'll go back to No. 1 al so. NSTAR/Eversource?

CONTI NUED PETI TI ON

EVERSOURCE - ALBANY STREET
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

This is al so conti nued fromlast month and this is Al bany Street and I think it was just
conti nued for meeti ngs and coordi nation with DPW?

Has that been -- have you met with DPW and the coor di nation?

RI CK SCHI FONE: Rick Schifone, R-I-C-K S-C-H-I-F-O-N-E, with Eversource.

Al bany Street, we're internally meeting wi th our gas company and us for the locations on Al bany Street, so we don't conflict with each ot her. So we'll have to request that we continue this until next month until we can decide whether -- what both of us can fit in that slot, that we don't have any construction obstacles bet ween the t wo of our compani es.

It is NSTAR gas and NSTAR el ectric and we have to work it out internally.

We both separately came in from these same spots.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: We have notes from Superintendent of Streets Mr. Dwyer asking that they make sure that you coordinate amongst themsel ves so that they can pave Al bany Street and Mass Ave at the same time.

RI CK SCHI FONE: I understand where Mr. Dwyer's coming from

From our end, it's whether or not we can go under each other's duct banks and with gas Iine is where we're having the issue. We'll take care of that internally.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So you are requesting to conti nue?

RI CK SCHI FONE: Yes.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: On the motion to continue?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I in favor?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yes.

CONTI NUED PETI TI ON

EVERSOURCE - CONCORD AVENUE

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Al so Eversource, this was al so conti nued and this is for Concord Avenue. And this is to feed the property down at 75 New Street. I bel i eve this was continued al so for DCR permits. Or coordi nation. And al so coordination with the city because that's -- that's going to be a wal kway at some time and I thi nk we were looking for facilities for lighting down that corridor.

RI CK SCHI FONE: Okay, we'll have to conti nue.

I don't have any additional i nf ormation beyond that we have applied for a DCR permit for
thei $r$ portion of the property and that's pending, the DCR permit. As far as Dr. Susan Aruda (phonetic) on -- provisions for any street lighting for the city.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So that would be a motion to continue.

Al so there should be a meeting with the el ectrical department, my department, just to go over that request, facilities for lighting.

RI CK SCHI FONE: We'll make note of that.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: It would be in the way of adding a conduit typical to most other requests for conduit in the street.

Motion to continue.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: AI I in favor?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yes.

NEW PETI TI ON

EVERSOURCE - FAYERVEATHER STREET

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Al so for Eversource. This is a new petition for Fayerweat her Street at Reservoir Street and northwesterly from pole 11, a di stance of about 66 feet of conduit. This work is necessary to supply power to 37 Fayerweat her Street.

I understand this was al ready installed,
this conduit?

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: The i nf or mation that
I have is from the pole to the private property I ine it has been installed.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Was
there a work order for that?

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: I don't know who installed it.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Is
that work for Eversource? I know the
intersection was just redone.
Has that conduit been confirmed that it does go where it needs to go.

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: I believe it does.
Our initial drawing for the project shows Eversource installing the conduit across the street from the pole to the handhole, and the customer taking it from the handhole in.

That was from August of 2016. And on an updated version with notes, handwritten notes on it, it shows that the conduit across the street has already been installed, not by us, not by Eversource.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So there's a four-inch gal vanized riser on that pole $11 ?$

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: I have not been out

there.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: You have not been there, okay.

So they are looking for a connection?
They are looking for it to be energized?
STEPHEN WASYLA JR: Yes.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I'm
sorry, there's a work order? Have they applied for a work order?

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: Yes, there's a work order.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So within your work order, would that have been the I ocation that they would be going to?

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: Yes. Al though I di dn't see. I'm going on notes that someone has gone out to the field to look at it.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Okay. If that four-inch -- you need to verify
that that four-i nch goes from pole 11 to their handhole, and if that was the case, then I don't have any issue of approving it.

I would like to find out who installed it. Can you send those back to us so we can make sure we touch base with them

If that conduit does not go to that handhole, then that intersection cannot be dug up. It's compl et el y re-bricked and raised, it was j ust done within a month or so.

RI CK SCHI FONE: Okay.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So

I guess -- what is the time frame that they are looking? Is there a push to get thi s done?

I know they are fed overhead right now.

STEPHEN WASYLA JR: I don't know about the ti metable.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I woul d like to continue just to verify that that

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four-inch conduit is, in fact, the one that goes
to the handhole and that's --
RI CK SCHI FONE: It meets.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
That it's installed to your specifications and that's where you want to go with it.
RI CK SCHI FONE: Okay.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Motion to conti nue.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I
in favor?
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Yes.
NEW PETI TI ON
EVERSOURCE - PHI LLI PS PLACE
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
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This is for Eversource, Phillips Place, northwesterly from private property to pick on southwesterly side of Phillips Place, approxi mately 200 feet southeast of St. John's Road to poi nt of pick up, a di stance of 210 feet of conduit. This work is necessary to supply power to Sherrill Hall at Lesley Uni versity.

So you are looking to go off the sidewalk within the gutter line?

RI CK SCHI FONE: Correct.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Motion to approve with conditions of meeting with Publ ic Works first and just touch base with the Water Department because there's a six-inch water mai $n$ that you may have to jump on $t$ he sidewal $k$ there.

I don't thi nk there's anything in the si dewal k, but bet ween coordi nation and meeting with DPW, to determi ne whet her there's space
there, and if you need to hop on $t$ he sidewal $k$, we would like a revised drawing.

RI CK SCHI FONE: Understood.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Motion to approve with typical conditions.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: And the ot her conditions.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: And
the conditions of a site meeting with Public Wbrks and Water Department.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Seconded.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I
in favor?
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Aye.

NEW PETI TI ON
COMCAST - MONSI GNOR O' BRI EN HI GHWAY
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Comcast?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Good morning.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
First petition is for Comast.
This is for Monsi gnor O' Brien Hi ghway.
Place one new $3 \times 5$ foot Comast manhole over existing Comcast conduit on Sciarappa Street.

Trench northerly 72 feet to Monsignor $\mathrm{O}^{\prime} \mathrm{Bri}$ en Hi ghway and then turning westerly on Monsi gnor O' Brien Hi ghway, continue 265 feet to 262 Monsi gnor O' Brien Hi ghway, installing one, four-inch PVC conduit.

This will include the removal and replacement of one sidewal $k$ panel by the builder.

ANTHONY VATALARO: So this is for that new residential buil ding going in. We have been
waiting on an 8 M permit and I have a copy of that, if you need it.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: What kind of permit?

ANTHONY VATALARO: It is MMRA, 8M. This is really 32 pages if you need the -- if you need the el ectronic file.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: I thi nk that a cover letter explaining the permit number and everything el se is fine. Although l'm not sure about Mr. Lenkauskas here. Do you want the 28 pages?

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I do not.

So you will have to get permitting through DCR al so?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Actually, did l mess that one up? That's the DCR permit, l think.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Yeah, this
is the MassDOT.

ANTHONY VATALARO: It is MassDOT.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Permit No.

6-2017-0047 and it is for the conduit
i nstallation at 262 Monsi gnor O' Brien Hi ghway.

ANTHONY VATALARO: So it is not MMRA?
It is MassDOT.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So you don't need an MMRA permit out there? ANTHONY VATALARO: No.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So
you are pi cking up on Sci arappa Street, are you just pi cking - you are going over the existing that feeds the hotel?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Exactly. We have -- I do have an engi neered drawing as well, if you want that.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I
think that was sent also. I do have that.

ANTHONY VATALARO: So we are going to pl ace a manhole over existing and conti nue from that point on.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Make a motion to approve with typical conditions and site meeting. The typical conditions with utility permitting and meeting with DPW

ANTHONY VATALARO: Okay.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: On the motion?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I
in favor?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yes.

NEW PETI TI ON
COMCAST - 300 THI RD STREET
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Al so Conctast, this is for 300 Third Street,
install one new $3 \times 5$ foot manhole over existing Comeast conduit on Third Street at Linskey hay. Trench southerly 135 feet installing two, four-inch PVC conduit and one additional $3 \times 5$ foot manhole. From the newly installed manhole on Thi rd Street at Li nskey way, trench southerly 49 feet installing one new sidewal $k$ vault in the grass and one, four-inch PVC conduit.

From the second new installed manhole, trench easterly 23 feet installing one new si dewalk vault in grass and one, four-inch PVC conduit.

So this is to remove those pol es?
ANTHONY VATALARO: Well, for us to get off those poles.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Not
to remove them

ANTHONY VATALARO: To prepare for that.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: And
feeding 300 Third Street, so will you be going to
that new manhol e?
ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes. So 300 Third
Street was approved I ast month.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Correct.
ANTHONY VATALARO: So they are actually
starting that work next week because Li nskey Way
is schedul ed to be paved. They are actually milling it Monday.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Okay.
ANTHONY VATALARO: So, yes, that will go
to the new manhole as opposed to going to the pole.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: And you've been coordinating with DPW as far as the milling and paving to get this --

ANTHONY VATALARO: We had a site visit with Lenny and the people at 100 Bi nney Street and Jaya is invol ved as well.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Okay. Motion to approve with typical conditions.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I in favor?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Yes.
ANTHONY VATALARO: Wbul d you want a revised drawing for -- I thi nk the old drawing for 300 Third Street went to the pole. I can revise it to go to the manhole.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Yes.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yes.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Thank you.

NEW PETI TI ON
COMCAST - 907 MAI N STREET

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Al so Comcast, this is for 907 Main Street. I
think on your application you put Mass Ave but it is actually Main.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I did.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I
think it was sent out to all the correct abutters, though.

ANTHONY VATALARO: "Mass at Main" is the name of the project.

Well, it's 907 Main is where the hotel is goi ng.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Okay. This will elim nate the trespass over that I ot?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes. So this will
el i minate the trespass over 907 Main Street where the new hotel is going, and it will al so
elim nate that -- the aerial connection frompole
to pole that they want taken down for the
9 Col umbi a Street, that new 140-unit complex.
So most of this trenching -- obviously,
the trench to recei ve Col umbia and 907, because
those are aerial right now, but then al so 403
Mass Ave and 875 Main need to be repl aced underground because those are al so aerial connections today.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So I'mokay with the laterals.

My one question is: Between the manhole and pole 6, so that's going -- that will pick up -- that's where you are going to pick up your
feed from?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes. So there's
another pole down by the lateral trench into

9 Col umbi a Street, and I probably should have put that on the drawing, that's that span of cable we met wi th the property owner they want taken down, that they said was part of the city conditions for their permit, was to take that down.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: A recommendation, but yeah.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Okay, I'mfine with it not goi ng away.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Ri ght. Well, my concern is with that -- I mean, if everything el se is not coming down, woul d you still be able to feed these properties?

ANTHONY VATALARO: No.
Then we have -- so the aerial trespass definitel y has to go away.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Correct.

ANTHONY VATALARO: So then I woul d have a problem with the amount of risers on that pole if that aerial span stays on the 9 Col umbia Street si de because then -- you know how many risers are going to be on that pole.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yeah, it cannot accommodate and that's al ready been di scussed with the devel oper and others.

ANTHONY VATALARO: So if that span stays and the 163 feet of trenching is eliminated, I would say l still put the manhol e over existing because I already have a riser on that pole and then I just do the laterals as-is on this drawing and you el i mi nate the 163 feet of trenching.

## Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Okay, there's al so other facilities on this pole here, both from Verizon and maybe Crown Castle.

If this street, in fact, needs to be dug up in the same direction, we need to do some -we need to at least contact them for a common trench for that 163-foot run.

What is the time frame for this?
ANTHONY VATALARO: He said he wanted it
this year.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Yeah.

ANTHONY VATALARO: But it seems like --

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: You are a piece of the puzzle, not the whole thing.

If they cant coordinate everything there then. . .

Would you be able to do that work and not do the 163 feet until such time that you make the -- everybody gets toget her over there and figures out what needs to be done?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Absol ut el $y$.

I could -- I don't need do the 68 feet of Col unbia Street because that will come when the building is built.

The 35 feet to 907, I could do today.
And the 15 feet I could do today. And then the 49 feet, I can do, which l would want to do, so I can elim nate that aerial trespass.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Uh- huh.

ANTHONY VATALARO: And then l can have all that in place and then l can take down the aerial trespass and we would be in good shape.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: So basically everything except the 68 feet?

ANTHONY VATALARO: And the 163.
Everything except for the 68 and the 163
because there's no clarity on that as far as it needing -- the aerial span needing to come down.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So a motion to approve all but the 163 -foot length onto pole 6 until we get clarification on other utilities as far as if everything is coming down there needs to be common trench or some coordinations because we are not digging the street three times in the same direction.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: And the 68, we are approving?

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I mean, the building is coming down. I don't think it makes sense to put that in --

ANTHONY VATALARO: Ri ght.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
-- until you have an exact location where that will be.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I can do a follow- up.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Everything but the 163 and the 68?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yeah.

I can do a follow- up application when the buil ding is ready.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So a motion to approve everything but the 68-foot section feeding 9 Col umbia Street and the 163-foot section to pole 6 on Col umbi a Street, and that will solve your issue with the aerial trespass to 907.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Al ong with the other property on Main Street and 403 Mass Ave.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Ri ght.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Okay.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: W th all
typical conditions and then an updated pl an?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Okay. Motion to approve with the conditions menti oned.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I
in favor?
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Yes.

NEW PETI TI ON
COMCAST - 190 MASS AVE

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
This is the last petition here for Verizon. This is to install approximately 75 feet of two ,
four-inch PVC conduit from an existing Verizon manhole 521 on Galileo Galilei Way, southeasterly through the property line of 145 Broadway to continue service and remove structure and property.

You are removing existing conduit?

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Whi ch one are you
reading from?
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: I was reading the one that was sent out on an abutter notice, structure currently extend service -- l'm sorry, it was removed structure.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: We were asked to get this so that the -- Boston Properties, whose doing the building in the spring, that our work woul d be done, so we woul dn't have to go in the street later on, so they have the location to just bring it to the property line because they haven't figured out which way they are going in the building at this time.

Verizon will just be breaking open into the manhole itself and then the devel oper will be pl acing the conduit.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Wthin the property? How do you feed the
property now?
ELI ZABETH KELLY: I don't know that ।
know that.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So
they are looking to get this work done to keep ahead of the scheduling of the property?

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Yes, uh-huh.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
There will be three conduits, one for the city?

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Three conduits and the si dewal $k$ plates, we are approximating that it will be two because they haven't figured out their whole plan yet and where their entranceway will be.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So will this change?

ELI ZABETH KELLY: No. That's why they want this to go in.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: So
this location is where they will be entering?
ELI ZABETH KELLY: Yes. And it gi ves them the flexi bility within thei $r$ private property to reroute there, reroute if they need to.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: On a rel ated -- on an unrel ated subject on double poles in the city with Verizon, we had a previous petition back in December for Verizon, and not a condition, but a recommendation, about work being done in the city or not being done in the city, and at that time they were -- they gave us an assurance that they would do -- they would complete the work on al most 70 -some-odd poles in the city, as a recommendation. It wasn't a condition of that petition. None of that has been done and they had gi ven us a deadline of March 1st of this year.

And they were saying at that time that there were 70-some-odd poles in your court to
be -- actually, 76 and the exact wording was
"Verizon will compl ete the remaining 76 where the ball is in Verizon's court by March 13, 2017 assuming that the work is not severely del ayed by wi nter weat her."

And we've recently compl et ed a survey of the city, and at this time, you have 103 balls in your court to get moving, so...

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: How about we don't issue the permits until they take them out?

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Well, at this point here, Verizon doesn't seem to be doing much of anything in the city, and the work is increasing so l don't know how we can gi ve you more work if you can't continue the work you have out there now.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Okay, I'II take that back.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: If
you can take that back and I thi nk that was -that letter was dated, I think, December 12, a recommendation. I think what we'll do is move to conti nue this petition until next month.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Okay.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: And

I need to get a clear schedule of work, and when it will be compl et ed before any permits will be i ssued.

The previ ous one we accepted and we'll conti nue to cover the size of that job, but I can't see giving Verizon any more in the city when there's unfini shed work that i ncreased dramatically.

We have al most 24 pol es out there that have nothing on them They are within Verizon's set area. All they need to do is remove the poles. There's no attachments. There's no transfers to be done.

All these were promised to be done as part of that 78 or 76 locations.

So l move to continue this petition to next month until we -- within the petition, when you come back, I would like to see this work either being done or in the process of with a firmschedule of it being done.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Okay.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Second.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Can you tell me the December 12 date you said? Is that the letter the city sent to Verizon or is that the response by Verizon to a previous letter?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Response from Verizon.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Okay.

## Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:

Correct. They were installing a -- we had the same issue, they were requesting to install a
small cell on a pole in Cambridge, and at that time, it was mentioned that -- creating more work on poles was going to be unacceptable because the work was not getting done, so they came back and it is in the last paragraph on there.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: It is
actually Shawn Conway (phonetic) was the person that wrote the letter, and he wrote it on January 10, 2017 and it was in response to the letter sent to them on December 12.

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Okay.

Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: And when we don't get to see Verizon here much, it is a hard time keeping up with the work being done out there, both on Iow hanging wires. We have Fire Department responses for low hanging wires. They are reported and they are not taken care of. There's main lines crossing the main streets from pol e-to-pole trunk lines, when they are called as
being low, and you know, Verizon is being sent out there and they are doing temporary repairs, not permanent repairs, just getting them up hi gh enough.

There's wires hanging all over the place and we are getting lots of complaints and not hing is being responded to.

So an overall condition to come back next month is you might want to talk to your fol ks and find out what type of schedule we can get to get some of this work done. So did we move to continue?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Yep.
Cl TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Al I in favor?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Aye.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Aye.

Could I give you a list of those pol es?

ELI ZABETH KELLY: Certai nly.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS:
Those are the poles clean and ready for removal.
No one else is on these poles. They are just, as they call them plank or wood and that would take a good chunk out of. Those were all on the original 70 -some-odd that they were going to move on back in -- by March 1st.

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Do you need a copy of your letter?

ELI ZABETH KELLY: That would be great.
CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: When we go upstairs, l'Il give them a copy of that letter.

CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: Motion to adjourn?

CHAI R NI COLE MURATI FERRER: Seconded.
CI TY ELECTRI CI AN STEPHEN LENKAUSKAS: AI I in favor?
