REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

Registration begins when you receive this brochure. Register daily 2:30-5:30pm in the Community Center cafeteria OR completed forms may be left in the Community School mailbox in the Graham & Parks Main Office. All registration forms will be processed on a first come first serve basis. Classes begin Monday, April 28. Piano lesson slots and "Dungeons and Dragons" class seats are saved throughout the academic year. Piano ends on Friday, June 13. Payment is expected at the time of registration. Please make check payable to "Community Schools"; one check for total amount per family. Your check is your receipt. If a class is full, you will be notified. If you are not notified, assume that your child is enrolled. Returned check fee is \$25 and it must be paid within 48 hours. Please note there is a \$25 academic year registration fee per child. Classes fill very quickly, so early registration is advised. Waiting lists will be taken for all classes.

- Children who need supervision from 2:25-3:15 are expected to register for the <u>Afterschool Activities Club</u> Fee: \$25/day covers the entire term.
- Classes <u>will</u> be held on Early Release Days. On Early Release days, special activities are offered from 12:30-3:15. Fee: \$20.00 Please register in advance; separate registration form available.
- No refunds after the first week, but children may choose another course, space permitting.
- New registrants should fill out the DHSP Form and pink emergency card.
- Children must remain in the Community School Center (cafeteria) while waiting for classes or pick-up.
- We are only responsible for children during the class time.
- Pick-up is expected as soon as classes end—either 4:15 or 5:15 for regular classes. Late pick-up fees charged at a rate of \$1.00/minute. We go by the cafeteria clock.
- Children with restricted diets/allergies must indicate so on registration form, and provide their own snack and EpiPen in case of emergency.
- Partial scholarships are available. You may request a Financial Aid Application. Income verification is required.
- Office hours 2:00-6:00 daily and Mondays & Thursdays until 7:00.
- Classes are not held when Cambridge Public Schools are closed.
- Some special activities will be offered during school vacations. More information forthcoming.
