- Explore the possibility of a joint CHA-Cambridge DPH pilot study to systematically test household contacts. The data collected would provide a measure of secondary attack rate for household contacts and assess feasibility of scaling up such a program. Discuss logistical details and additional partners.
- 2. Mem Dr. trial opening— crowd control? Masks? Any improvements needed?

 Jill queried interest at Broad for measuring virus+ rate among outdoor exercise cohort.
- 3. Discussion with Eric and Mariana from Biobot. Many local universities and colleges have announced opening for the fall- can we get biobot, and direct communications set up with their med. depts. in place now to help minimize resulting transmission in our community?
- 4. The school superintendent is seeking folks for a panel re school reopening. Can they offer remote learning to anyone who would like or needs that option for any reason? Important to limit crowding and reduce transmission.
- 5. Last week we did not have a chance to discuss symptoms among children, how that can be communicated to the public and the relevance to our city reopening.

Note: Two news articles misrepresented data about Battelle N95 decontamination method (Battelle now in Somerville, serving MA). Jill queried multiple HCW N95 reusers in Boston, no problems reported.
