Y Code of Conduct

The Cambridge Family Y is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all of our members and guests. To ensure safety and comfort for all, we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times while they are in our facility or while they are participating in YMCA programs.

We expect persons using the Y to behave in a nature and responsible way and respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Code of Conduct does not permit language or action that can hurt or frighten another person or falls below a generally accepted standard of conduct. Specifically this includes:

- Angry and vulgar language including swearing, name-calling and shouting
- Physical contact with another person in any angry or threatening way
- Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact with another person
- Harassment or intimidation by any means not tolerated
- Theft or destruction of property
- Carrying or concealing any weapons or devises that may be used as a weapon
- The sale, possession, distribution, or use of any illegal substance (including alcohol) by an individual on Y property is prohibited and will constitute grounds for immediate termination and possible prosecution.

Members are encouraged to be responsible for their personal conduct and safety and to ask any person whose behavior threatens their personal comfort to refrain. Staff are trained and expected to respond to any reported violation of our Code of Conduct. Please don't hesitate to notify a staff person if you need assistance.

The Y management will investigate all reported incidents. Suspension or termination of Y membership privileges may result from any violation of the Code of Conduct.
