Concord Ave Neighborhood streets and sidewalks will be fully reconstructed (beginning in January 2014) as part of the "Concord Ave" phase of the Department of Public Works Alewife Sewer Separation Project. This project will include subsurface utility upgrades to separate stormwater and sewer infrastructure to reduce discharges to the Alewife Brook, resulting in the elimination of a combined sewer overflow and improved water quality. Upon completion of the subsurface utility work, there will be streetscape improvements completed along Concord Ave and the surrounding residential streets.

We strongly encourage you to attend the community meetings on June 19th and June 27th to learn more about the Concord Ave Neighborhood Project and to provide your input on the design.
