The City of Cambridge's GLBT Commission is seeking nominations for the annual Bayard Rustin Service Award, which is an honor bestowed to a person of color with an outstanding history of service to the GLBT Community. The award will be presented at the annual Cambridge Pride Celebration, a tradition which takes place in Cambridge City Hall on the morning of the Boston Pride Parade.

Bayard Rustin was an American civil rights activist in the 1960s. He counseled Martin Luther King, Jr. and was the chief organizer of the March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom in 1963. Working tirelessly to advocate for GLBT causes in the latter part of his career, he courageously stood in defiance of the viciously negative attitudes towards GLBT community members.

Nominees must be past or present residents of Cambridge, or currently work in or have worked in Cambridge. Nominees may not be members of the Cambridge GLBT Commission, or family members of a commissioner. Nominees may be city employees if they are being nominated for service beyond the scope of their employment. Posthumous nominations will also be accepted and considered.
